Western Massachusetts Council:

For Eagle Scout Boards of Review, after the Eagle Scout application has been submitted to the Registrar for certification it will be mailed to the Scoutmaster with the contact information of the appropriate District Advancement Chair to contact to set up a Board of Review in Appalachian Trail and Metacomet Districts

In the General Knox District Eagle Scout candidates are to present themselves at the Springfield City Hall on the second Tuesday of the month for their Board of Review. Boards are held from 5:45PM to 7:00PM.

ALL Eagle Rank Applications should be submitted to the Lancaster Service Center by the Scout in full Class A uniform. Your statement of ambition should be included. Electronic submittal via signed .pdf copies are acceptable while Covid-19 restrictions are in place. Mr. Hardies will contact the persons listed on your application for recommendations, so make sure you give good contact information, and we recommend you let them know they will be approached by Council. You may provide additional references -in fact you are encouraged to. You will be contacted by your Scoutmaster approximately 3 weeks after submittal to schedule your Board.
